vegetarían Sloppy Joes

- 1 1/2 Cups Red Onion, Chopped
- 1 Cup Celery, Chopped
- 1 Cup Carrot, Chopped
- 1 Cup Crimini Mushrooms, Chopped
- 1 Tsp Sea Salt, divided
- 1 Tablespoon Dried Oregano

Fresh Ground Black Pepper

- 1 Block Extra Firm Tofu, Crumbled (or Substitute 1 pound Ground Beef)
- 2 Teaspoons Garlic, minced
- 2 Teaspoons Garlic Granules
- 26 ounces Spaghetti Sauce (I used Hunts)

In a sauté pan, sweat vegetables in a little olive oil with salt until almost translucent then add crumbled Tofu and spices. Cook for about 10 minutes or until most of the moisture has evaporated and the tofu begins to brown. Add Spaghetti Sauce (canned or from your own recipe) and cook on medium high heat (or slightly lower if it is spitting all over your kitchen) until the sauce thickens. Serve on Onion Buns or your favorite hearty bread with a good strong cheese.
